Apgar Village Lodge & Cabins /

Apgar Village Lodge & Cabins, located in historic Apgar Village inside the National Park, offers easy access to the most popular activities in Glacier. You can rent a bike, take a swim in Lake McDonald, or rent a boat and paddle the calm lake waters all steps from your accommodations. Hiking trails are plentiful in the area. The free National Park Service Shuttle stops in Apgar village and can take you to various stops along the Going-to-the-Sun Road. The modest motel rooms at Apgar Village Lodge offer an inexpensive option for staying within the park boundaries. Perfect for families, most of the cabins have fully outfitted kitchens providing the comforts of home. Each cabin is unique and offers an unbeatable Glacier National Park experience.

West Glacier Motel & Cabins /

For a quiet, comfortable night of sleep, join us at the West Glacier Motel & Cabins. Rustic in style, they feature all the modern amenities you need for an enjoyable stay near Glacier National Park. West Glacier Motel & Cabins includes 32 non-smoking units, all with a shower, electric heat, carpet, and alarm clock. Eighteen of the motel units are located in West Glacier Village, along the famous Going-to-the-Sun Road at the west entrance of Glacier National Park. Each cabin is fully equipped with a refrigerator, stove, sink, dishes, pots and pans, silverware, coffee maker, toaster and all linens. Plan a cookout around the fire pit or enjoy a warm campfire in our picnic area, while feasting on the views of Glacier National Park's mountain peaks.

Motel Lake McDonald /

Located 10 miles inside Glacier National Park's west entrance on the Going-to-the-Sun Road, Motel Lake McDonald is nestled quaintly near the shores of the largest lake inside the park.
